1. ADULT PLAYERS

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game especially when you act as important and influential role models for Chipstead's junior members.

Please play your part and observe the Club's Respect Code of Conduct for players at all times.

ON & OFF THE FIELD, I WILL:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote Fair Play
- Always respect the match official decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of any match official
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation, or harassment
- Treat my team-mates, coaches/managers, and the opposition with respect at all times
- Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game.

I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DO NOT FOLLOW THIS CODE, ANY/ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS MAY BE TAKEN BY MY CLUB:







I MAY:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, opposition team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the Coach
- Receive a written warning from the Club Committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Not be selected for future matches
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be asked to leave the Club

IN ADDITION:

• The County FA/The FA could impose a fine and/or suspension against the Club.
